

Upon consideration of the motion (the "Motion") of the debtors and debtors in possession in the above-captioned jointly-administered chapter 11 cases (the "Debtors") for an Order (A) Establishing March 3, 2003 at 4:00 p.m., prevailing Eastern Time, as the Bar Date for Filing Proofs of Claim for Asbestos-Related Damage to Property Located in the United States and Canada; (B) Approving Proposed Proof of Claim Form for Such Asbestos-Related Property Damage Claims; and (C) Approving Scope and Manner of Notice of Bar Date for Asbestos-Related Property Damage Claims; the Court having reviewed the Motion and any responses thereto; and the Court finding that (i) the Court has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157 and 1334, (ii) this is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2) and (c), (iii) notice of the Motion and the hearing was adequate and sufficient under the circumstances, and (iv) it appearing that the relief requested in the Motion is in the best interests of the Debtors and their estates; it is hereby

ORDERED, that pursuant to section 105 of title 11 of the United States Code (the "Bankruptcy Code") and Federal Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 3002(c)(3), all persons and entities, including, without limitation, individuals, partnerships, corporations, estates, trusts, and governmental units (each a "Creditor" and collectively, the "Creditors") holding or wishing to assert asbestos-related property damage claims (each an "Asbestos-Related PD Claim")² arising from damage to any property or property interest located in the United States or Canada against any of the Debtors' estates (such Asbestos-Related PD Claims to be referred to herein as the "North American PD Claims"), **are required to file, at or before 4:00 p.m. prevailing Eastern Time on March 3, 2003** (the "Bar Date"), a separate, completed and executed proof of claim

form, conforming substantially to the claim form attached to the Motion as Exhibit C (the "PD Proof of Claim Form") on account of each North American PD Claim such Creditor wishes to assert; and it is further

ORDERED, that proofs of claim on account of North American PD Claims shall be filed with the Debtors' claims agent at the following addresses:

and it is further

ORDERED, that for any North American PD Claim to be validly and properly filed, a signed original of a completed PD Proof of Claim Form, together with any accompanying supporting documents and information required by such form, must be delivered to the Debtors' claims agent, The Garden City Group, Inc., at the address identified on the PD Claims Bar Date Notice so as to be received no later than 4:00 p.m., prevailing Eastern Time, on the PD Claims Bar Date; and it is further

ORDERED, that properly completed PD Proof of Claim Forms must be submitted in person or by courier service, hand delivery, or mail, and that proofs of claim on account of North American PD Claims submitted by email or facsimile will not be accepted; and it is further

ORDERED, that proofs of claim will be deemed filed when actually received by the Debtors' claims agent; and it is further

ORDERED, that all entities asserting North American PD Claims against more than one Debtor be, and hereby are, required to file a separate PD Proof of Claim Form with respect to each such Debtor; and it is further

ORDERED, that the Debtors shall cause notice of the PD Claims Bar Date to be mailed to those creditors specified in paragraphs 15 to 17 of the Motion in accordance with the procedures and timeline described in the Affidavit of Wayne L. Pines attached as Exhibit E to the Motion ("Pines Affidavit"), and that such notice program for providing mailed notice of the PD Claims Bar Date be, and hereby is, approved as good and sufficient notice to known creditors of the PD Claims Bar Date; and it is further


ORDERED, that the Debtors shall cause notice of the PD Claims Bar Date to be published in accordance with the procedures and timeline described in the Pines Affidavit, and that such publication notice shall constitute good and sufficient notice to unknown creditors of the PD Claims Bar Date; and it is further

ORDERED, that the form of mailed and publication notices attached to the Motion as Exhibits A and B are hereby approved; and it is further

ORDERED, that the PD Proof of Claim Form attached to the Motion as Exhibit C is hereby approved; and it is further

ORDERED, that this Order shall apply to all North American PD Claims that may be asserted against any of the Debtors.
